AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-301 to 75-322 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passenger by vans in open class service between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, Cass, Otoe, Washington, Saunders, and Dodge Counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: a) A maximum of six (6) vehicles total in service and/or operation at any given point in time within the following counties: Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, Cass, Otoe, Washington, Saunders, and Dodge; and b) The transportation of passengers funded through the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services' Division of Children and Family Services is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.
