

We live at 1234 S. 25th Rd Cortland, 1-1/8 miles east of town. Sometimes one of us works from home on the computer, which depends on fast internet. Our Windstream DSL is 15Mbps download speeds and 1.25 upload speeds. When we try to upload videos to YouTube for a local nonprofit, the upload is so slow that YouTube times out and we have to try multiple times. Our Windstream DSL is unreliable and we have frequently have to call Windstream to send a service person to fix the service, which often takes several days for someone to come out. During the COVID lock down, the internet speeds were half what they should be, and the repair person found a cable had been cut, apparently by a person. Other excuses over the years include a squirrel chewed a line, a fire in a ditch burned a connector box, and the "switch" in Cortland had been replaced but it was faulty. Our two security cams use wi fi. We'd love to have more security cams which would need more bandwidth.


