OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") initiated this proceeding on its own motion to administer the 2023 program year of the Nebraska Broadband Bridge Program ("NBBP").

On May 16, 2023 the Commission entered an order in this Docket, which, among other things, set the NBBP 2023 Procedural Schedule, including a deadline of Monday, June 26, 2023, for the submission of funding applications ("May 16 Order"). As noted in the May 16 Order, the June $26^{\rm th}$ date was selected, in part, to address concerns expressed by commenters that the submission of applications around the July 4 holiday could be problematic.

After the May 16 Order was issued, the Legislature adopted LB 683, which was signed by Governor Pillen on May 26, 2023. LB 683 includes an emergency clause and, therefore, is now in effect. Section 26 of LB 683 (to be codified at Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-1304) has removed a former requirement that annual NBBP funding applications be submitted on or before July 1 for each fiscal year. In its place, the statute now provides for NBBP application deadlines to be established by the Commission, with publication of such deadlines to be made on the Commission's website.

In light of the forgoing, I find it to be in keeping with the purposes of the Nebraska Broadband Bridge Program, and in the interest of NBBP applicants, that the deadline to submit applications be extended from June 26, 2023 to July 11, 2023, with concomitant extensions to all subsequent dates on the NBBP 2023 Procedural Schedule. The revised procedural schedule is attached hereto as Attachment A.
