The purpose of this letter is to inform you that ALLO Communications intends to apply to the Nebraska Public Service Commission for a Capital Projects Fund grant to provide broadband internet service in your community. We are seeking feedback from the City of Scottsbluff leadership regarding the proposed project.

Description of the Project and Technology to be Used:

ALLO will provide broadband service to the area North of Scottsbluff through an all Fiber-to-the-Premise network.

Proposed Speed Tiers and Pricing:

ALLO provides ubiquitous 1+ Gbps service with symmetrical speeds (delivering the same download and upload speeds) to entities including residences, businesses, and government entities. The standard offerings are symmetrical speeds at 500 Mbps (\$69/month), and 1 Gbps (\$98/month).
