ALLO currently provides (or is in the process of providing) 1 Gbps+ service to the Nebraska communities of Lincoln, Bellevue, Grand Island, Kearney, Fremont, Hastings, Norfolk, Columbus, Papillion, North Platte, La Vista, Scottsbluff, York, Seward, Gering, Alliance, Sidney, Wayne, Gretna, Ogallala, Waverly, Ashland, Valentine, Milford, Imperial, and Bridgeport.

Independently, in June 2022, PCMag listed ALLO as the [5<sup>th</sup> fastest ISP in the United States and 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest in the North Central Region](#) with a 289 upload and 309 download average (Nebraska communities). Speeds were derived from customers visiting [speedtest.net](https://www.speedtest.net).

For our marketing/advertising approach, ALLO uses various communication channels to reach customers, including website, direct sales, referrals, newspaper, radio, television, social media, and sponsorships. These marketing channels have been used successfully in our existing FTTP communities.
