RESTRICTIONS: Open class service in Douglas County is limited to service originating in Lincoln, dropping of at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, and returning to Lincoln. Applicant is limited to a maximum of two (2) vans in service at any one time. HHS Designation: Yes.
