NEBRASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TITLE 291 – NEBRASKA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION CHAPTER 2- ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS

001 SCOPE.

<u>001.01 GENERAL.</u> These rules and regulations govern administrative policies as set forth in Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-104, Laws of 1994.

001.02 DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

001.02A COMMISSION. Nebraska Public Service Commission.

<u>001.02B IN THE LINE OF DUTY.</u> Attendance at meetings and hearings which relates to the business of the Commission.

<u>001.02C RESIDENCE.</u> The domicile maintained in the district which the Commissioner is elected to represent.

<u>001.02D TRAVEL.</u> Travel to and from a Commissioner's residence to the Commission office.

002 REIMBURSEMENT.

<u>002.01 AUTHORIZED EXPENSES.</u> Commissioners may receive, from the state, mileage expenses incurred while traveling to and from their residences to the Commission office.

<u>002.02 STIPULATIONS.</u> To receive reimbursement for mileage, the following conditions must be met:

002.02A. Travel must be conducted in the line of duty.

<u>002.02B.</u> The mileage rate allowable for travel reimbursement shall not exceed the mileage rate established by the Department of Administrative Services pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 81-1176.

<u>002.02C.</u> Mileage expenses incurred while traveling to and from a Commissioner's residence to the Commission office in Lincoln must be reported as taxable income.

<u>002.02C1.</u> To report such travel and receive reimbursement, a separate Expense Reimbursement Document, as approved by the Department of Administrative Services, must be completed.

003 APPROPRIATIONS.

<u>003.01 FUNDING</u>. Mileage expenses, as allowed in this chapter, shall be funded from the program established for Commissioner's expenses.

<u>003.02 AMOUNT</u>. The total amount authorized for reimbursement of Commissioner's expenses in any fiscal year, including mileage, shall not exceed the total funds that are appropriated to the program established for such expenses.
