Consolidated's current rate \$99.95 rate for 100/100 Mbps service is contained on Consolidated's website (screen shot below). Upon being awarded a grant in the 2022 Broadband Bridge Program Bridge Act Program, Consolidated will offer 100/100 Mbps service for \$79.95 in the awarded project areas. Consolidated's internet service does not have data caps, usage limitations, long term contracts, early termination fees or metered "pay-as-you-go" type of service.

To further support that the \$79.95 retail rate for 100/100 Mbps is comparable, Consolidated looked at the FCC's most recent Urban Rate Survey results (FCC Public Notice DA 21-1588 rel. December 16, 2021). In this survey, the FCC's benchmark retail rate for 100/100 Mbps service is \$96.47 (screen shot below).
