Attachment D – Noncontiguous Areas

York County grant would build fiber-to-the-home as a noncontiguous project. This project is made up of two noncontiguous areas that will connect to Glenwood's existing fiber network already in place in north central Fillmore County.

There is one location in the Fairmont exchange that makes this project noncontiguous, as it is to be constructed off a nearby existing Glenwood fiber. The other 52 locations are contiguous within the adjacent exchanges of Exeter and McCool Junction.

These areas are noncontiguous and have a natural connection to one another, all within unserved rural areas and adjacent exchanges of Fairmont, Exeter, and McCool Junction. Glenwood respectfully ask that this application be considered as a single project.
