Great Plains Communications (GPC) will construct 59,000 feet of new fiber optic facility within the city of Arnold, Nebraska. The project will be constructed buried. GPC will leverage 35,000 feet of existing buried conduit that will equal approximately 60% of the overall project. There will be 24,000 feet of new buried conduit installed. The project will pass approximately 353 homes and businesses. The newly constructed fiber plant will receive bandwidth from a Great Plains owned and operated extensive state and regional long-haul fiber network, which can provide multiple 100 Gbps bandwidth circuits for existing and future bandwidth needs in the town of Arnold from multiple regional Internet providers.
