Great Plains Communications (GPC) will construct 77 miles of new fiber optic facility within the rural coverage area of Wausa, Nebraska. The project will be constructed buried and will pass approximately 78 homes and businesses. The newly constructed fiber plant will receive bandwidth from GPC’s owned and operated extensive state and regional long-haul fiber network that can provide multiple 100 Gbps bandwidth circuits for existing and future bandwidth needs in the rural Wausa area from multiple regional Internet providers.
