3. A copy of the latest Form 10-K or equivalent.
3a. Carrier is not required to file a form 10-K or equivalent with the Securities and Exchange Commission.
4. A copy of the 2022 Annual Report to Stockholders or provide a website where available.
4a. Carrier does not publish an Annual Report to Stockholders.
5. A description of the carrier's 2023 and 2024 construction budget, including a brief description of any projects as outlined in 5a and 5b.
5a. Carriers having a construction budget in excess of \$10 million, include any projects having a value in excess of \$100,000.
5b. Carriers having a construction budget less than \$10 million, include any projects having a value in excess of \$50,000.
5c. Carrier has no construction budget meeting the requirements of 5a or 5b.
6. A detailed listing of access lines by exchange. Disaggregate the total number of access lines by Residential, business, VoIP, resold, company official, and total company access lines.
