#### **RDOF DEPLOYMENT INFORMATION**

Applicant asserts that areas within the project footprint where AMG Technology Investment Group, LLC ("AMG") won RDOF bids are eligible for grants under the Broadband Bridge program. Upon information and belief, AMG will not be capable of providing broadband and voice services in those areas within two years, as required by the Commission's Order entered in C-5272 on August 10, 2021, at p. 6. The FCC has not yet authorized AMG to receive RDOF support, and there is no evidence to indicate that AMG is in a position to deploy fiber-based infrastructure in Nebraska, in the project footprint within two years.
