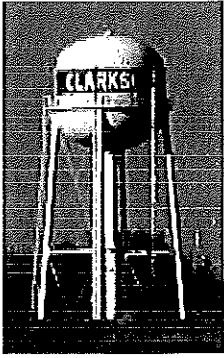

Antenna supplied internet fails for us every summer when the trees are in foliage or when we have storms that limit the reception of important safety data.

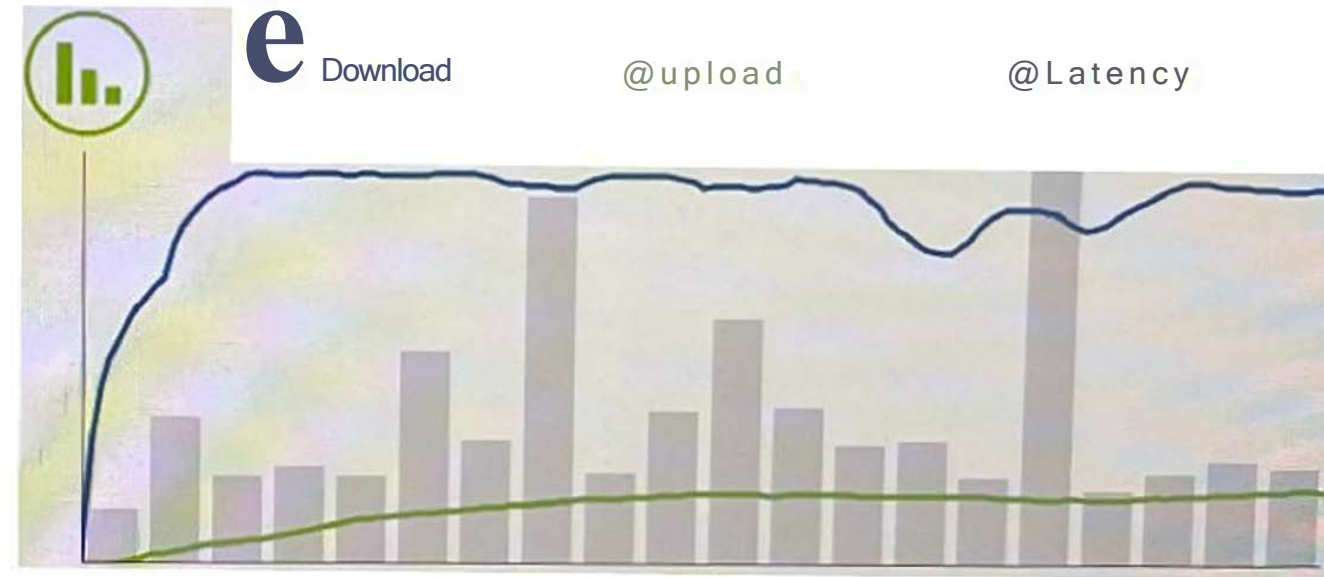
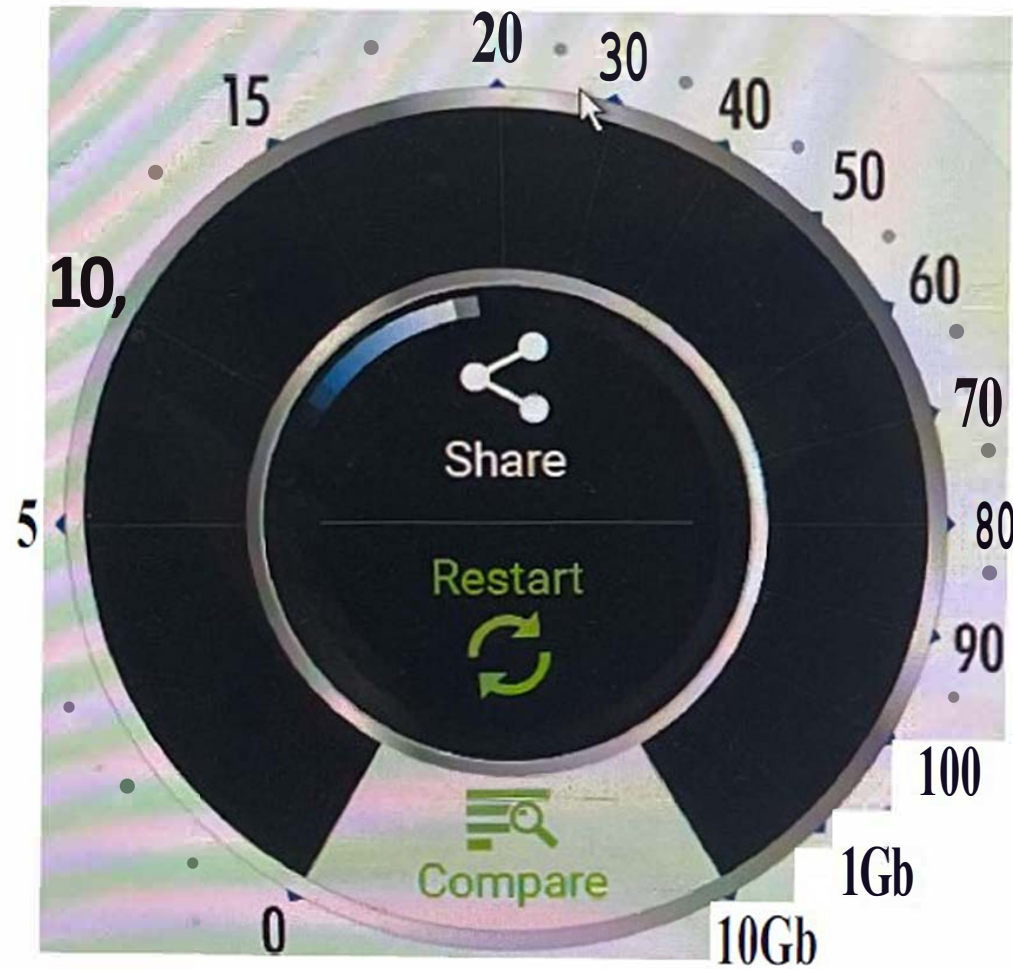
