a) Project Details

Applicant: Midstates Data Transport, LLC d/b/a Stealth Broadband

Project: Platte County North Unserved

Project Total Cost: \$658,820

NBBP Requested Funds: \$559,997

Description: Fiber to the Home build in rural Platte County serving 14 unserved locations

b) Risk Factors / Legal

c) Financial Analysis

Stealth Broadband began operations in January 2016. In 2021, our fifth year in business, the company generated \$3.5M in revenue serving 2,450 customers across 26 communities in Northeast Nebraska. In 2022, Stealth generated \$4M in revenue serving 2,900 customers in Nebraska. In 2023, Stealth expects to generate \$4.7M in revenue serving over 3,400 customers in Nebraska.

From an overall financial strategy standpoint, Stealth Broadband has two related sister companies who provide broadband engineering and fiber splicing services, as well as managed IT services. Combined, these two sister companies generated \$3.92M of revenue in 2022, contributing \$1M in positive EBITDA, and thus positive cashflow to support the growing Stealth Broadband network and customer base.

Stealth Broadband and their sister companies have maintained their banking relationship with Elkhorn Valley Bank of Norfolk since inception and have operated in compliance with all terms and covenants throughout their history. A letter of reference from Elkhorn Valley Bank is attached.

Positive cash flow on this project is achieved in year 2 post-installation. During the year leading up to positive cash flow, the company will need to supplement operations with cash generated from other business activities or a bank operating line of credit. At peak, this project will require \$1,637 cash which is well within the capability of the current operations and banking relationship noted above.

d) Long-term Maintenance

Since inception, Stealth Broadband has used Bauer Underground and Turnkey Telecom Solutions for construction, engineering, splicing and restoration services. Stealth’s strong relationship with these two companies has resulted in sustained growth, quick customer turn-ups and expedited responses to fiber outages. Stealth maintains its own staff of network technicians, installation technicians and locators to ensure the network is reliable and to maximize up-time for our customers. Stealth works with all jurisdictions including state, county, and city / village on fiber relocation projects.

e) Prior Federal Funding

Stealth has not received any federal funding since inception.

f) Community Engagement

This project is a rural only project with 100% of the design within Platte County, Nebraska. On January 27, 2023, Stealth was awarded a \$1,000,000 award from Platte County to extend fiber to the home to parts of rural Platte County. Stealth has a great working relationship with the Platte County Board of Supervisors. The chairperson of that board, Kim Kwapnioski has submitted a letter of

support for our project included in attachment M of this application. We have received several other letters of support that do not include the required information in the application guide. Those are also included in attachment M. Stealth will follow up with all parties who have shown support to ensure that they follow the exact process prior to the April 24, 2023 deadline.

Stealth does not expect any negative feedback for our application. We have a great working relationship with all involved and believe that this project will be fully supported by various stakeholders.
