NUSF-99 PRICE CAP APPLICATION – Juniata Exchange NE

Windstream's Response:

Windstream submits the following project for the Commission's consideration of NUSF-99 broadband funding, to be constructed upon funding approval, using funding available from the 2018 funding allocation.

• Fiber-to-the Prem to serve a portion of the Northeastern area of the Juniata, NE ILEC Exchange (partial funding requested)

This area of the Juniata Exchange is not currently offered broadband service above 4Mbps. This project intends to address these customers by placing fiber-to-the-prem to provide download and upload speeds of up to 1Gbps.

- The project will place approximately 3.5 miles of fiber to enable symmetrical FttP services.
- The installation and use of optical equipment within the central office to provide direct service to individual residences and businesses

Windstream projects the total deployment costs for this project is \$260,103 and Windstream is requesting Nebraska Universal Service Funding of \$70,937, not including ROW and IDC. The difference between the total project costs and the requested funding is because Windstream is not seeking funding for the areas funded by the FCC's Connect America Fund Phase 2 program, areas where Windstream already provides broadband service up to 10Mbps download speeds, or areas where a terrestrial competitor already provides broadband service up to 10Mbps download speeds. Windstream is requesting that the funding for this project be applied against the remaining 2018 funds allotted to Windstream.

Windstream Response:

Attached Checklist Item #6 provides a listing of the retail pricing for the broadband services Windstream will be offering in the proposed service areas. This price list is consistent with Windstream pricing for similar services in other Nebraska exchanges.

Windstream Response:

If approved for funding, Windstream commits to offer broadband service to all households within the service area of the project for a minimum of five (5) years.
