


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

I. Application of Tariff

The regulations, terms and conditions applicable to the provision of Switched Access and Special Access Services, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s), provided by Pinpoint Communications, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the Company, to Intrastate Customers, hereinafter referred to as IXCs, are the same as those filed in the Nebraska Independent Telephone Association (NITA) Tariff, Sections 1-16, except as noted herein.



The rates, charges, and, where applicable, exception regulations for such services are detailed in Section 2 of this catalog.

The provision of such service by the Company as set forth in the NITA Tariff and in Section 2 of this catalog is specifically intended to provide exchange network access to IXCs for their own use or in furnishing their authorized intrastate services to End Users, and for operational purposes directly related to the furnishing of their authorized services. Operational purposes include testing and maintenance of circuits, demonstration and experimental services and spare services. Telephone Exchange Services required by the IXC for its administrative use are furnished under other applicable tariffs of the Company. The Company will determine, based on the IXC's use of the facilities involved, whether the Access Rates and Charges as specified herein or Rates and Charges as specified in other tariffs of the Company apply.

1.1 Whenever reference is made in this Company's tariffs to other tariffs of the Company, the reference is to the tariffs in force as of the effective date of those tariffs, and to amendments thereto and successive issues thereof.

2.1.2 General Description

Carrier Common Line (CCL) service provides for the use of Company common lines by customers for access to end users to furnish intrastate telecommunications service. It includes: 1) Switched Access service provided to customers under this catalog for intrastate MTS/WATS; 2) originating Switched Access service in an end office converted to equal access, and 3) all terminating access.

2.1.3 Limitations

WATS Access Lines

Where Switched Access services are connected with Special Access services at Company designated WATS serving offices for the provision of WATS or WATS-type services, Switched Access service minutes-of-use (MOU) that are carried on that end of the service; i.e., originating MOU for outward WATS and WATS-type services and terminating MOU for inward WATS and WATS-type services, shall not be assessed CCL charges.

2.1.4 Undertaking of the Company

(A) Provision of Service

Where the customer is provided Switched Access Service as provided for in this catalog or other Access Service catalogs/tariffs, the Company will provide the use of Company common lines by a customer for access to end users at rates as set forth in 2.1.1 above.

(B) Interstate and Intrastate Use

The Switched Access service provided by the Company includes the Switched Access service provided for both interstate and intrastate communications. CCL rates and charges as set forth in 2.1.1 above apply to intrastate Switched Access service access minutes in accordance with the Percent Intrastate Use (PIU) rate regulations as set forth in 2.1.7 (C) below.


2.1.5 Obligations of the Customer

The Switched Access service associated with CCL shall be ordered by the customer under other sections of this catalog.

The customer facilities at the premises of the ordering customer shall provide the necessary on-hook and off-hook supervision.

2.1.6 Determination of Usage Subject to CCL Charges

When the customer reports interstate and intrastate use of Switched Access service, the associated CCL used by the customer for intrastate will be determined as set forth in 2.1.7 (C) below.

(B) Usage Recording by the Customer


Where end office switching is provided without Company recording and the customer records MOU used to determine CCL charges the customer shall furnish such MOU detail to the Company in a timely manner. If the customer does not furnish the data, the customer shall identify all Switched Access services which could carry such calls in order for the Company to accumulate the MOU through the use of special Company measuring and recording equipment.


(B) Measuring and Recording of Call Detail

When access minutes are used to determine CCL charges, they will be accumulated using call detail recorded by Company equipment and operator and automated operator services call detail. The Company measuring and recording equipment will be associated with end office or local tandem switching equipment and will record each originating and terminating access minute where answer supervision is received. The accumulated access minutes will be summed on a line-by-line basis, by line group or by end office, whichever type of account is used by the Company for each customer and then rounded to the nearest minute.

(C) Percent Intrastate Use

When the customer reports intrastate and interstate use of in-service Switched Access service, CCL charges will be billed only to intrastate Switched Access service minutes, based on the data reported by the customer as set forth in 2.3.11 (C) of the NITA Access Service Catalog (Jurisdictional Reports), except where the Company is billing according to actuals by jurisdiction. Intrastate Switched Access service access minutes will be used to determine CCL charges as set forth in 2.1.7 (D) below.
