Subject: Seeking Community Feedback on Proposed Broadband Deployment Project

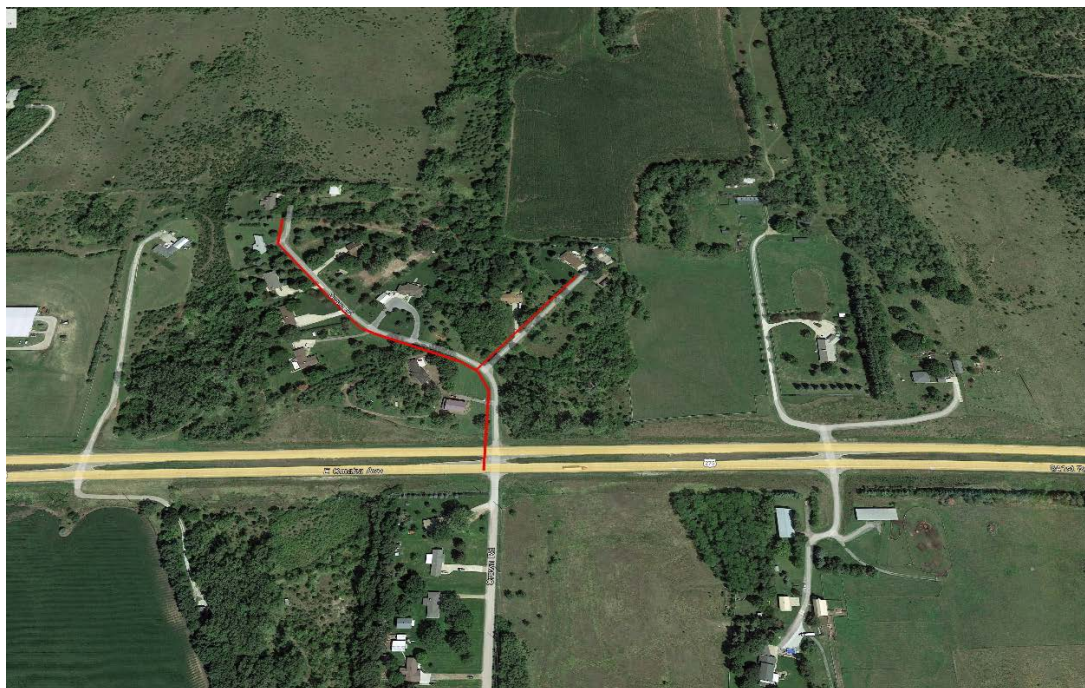

- 500/500 Mbps \$85
- 1Gig/1Gig \$99
