AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2015), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: The transportation of passengers by limousine, sedan, SUV, and van over irregular routes between points in Adams, Blaine, Boone, Buffalo, Clay, Custer, Dawson, Fillmore, Franklin, Frontier, Furnas, Garfield, Gosper, Greeley, Hall, Hamilton, Harlan, Hoard, Kearney, Lincoln, Loup, Madison, Merrick, Nance, Nuckolls, Phelps, Platte, Polk, Red Willow, Sherman, Thayer, Valley, Webster, Wheeler and York counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.as a limousine service
